

Aim Youth Councils Network

POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

PRESIDENT

Serves as executive leader of the Steering Committee, including overseeing meetings and activities of the Steering Committee to ensure the group is meeting its goals. Will have speaking roles at Legislative Day and the 2018-19 Youth Leadership Summit. Dates of those events are TBD, but will likely occur in January 2019 and March 2019.

REGIONAL DIRECTOR – NORTH

Must represent a Youth Council whose City Hall or Town Hall is located in the First, Second or Third Congressional District. Serves as a liaison between the Steering Committee and Youth Councils located in the North Region. Assists the President in coordinating Steering Committee activities.

REGIONAL DIRECTOR – CENTRAL

Must represent a Youth Council whose City Hall or Town Hall is located in the Fourth, Fifth or Seventh Congressional District. Serves as a liaison between the Steering Committee and Youth Councils located in the Central Region. Assists the President in coordinating Steering Committee activities.

REGIONAL DIRECTOR – SOUTH

Must represent a Youth Council whose City Hall or Town Hall is located in the Sixth, Eighth or Ninth Congressional District. Serves as a liaison between the Steering Committee and Youth Councils located in the South Region. Assists the President in coordinating Steering Committee activities.

SECRETARY

Facilitates communication among Steering Committee members and records topics discussed at Steering Committee meetings. Oversees the social media channels of the Aim Youth Councils Network, including Instagram and Twitter. Coordinates communication to the general Youth Council membership. Assists with media relations.

TREASURER

Assists Aim staff with the budget of the Youth Councils Network, including helping to secure grants and sponsorship funding for network activities.

EVENTS COORDINATOR

Assists Aim staff with the planning of Legislative Day and the Youth Leadership Summit. Also responsible for helping to grow the network's programming during the 2018-19 school year.
