The 26th Annual ILMCT Institute & Academy promises great learning experiences and networking. This year's event is taking place virtually **March 15-18**. Cost for the entire event is **\$300**, and registration for individual days is available.

Find attached the scholarship form for the Institute & Academy. **All ILMCT Institute & Academy Scholarship applications must be received no later than Friday, February 19, 2021.** Scholarship recipients will be notified of acceptance by Tuesday, February 23. Please note: Deputies are not eligible for scholarships.

If you have already registered and paid for the Institute & Academy, you may still apply for a scholarship. If you secure a scholarship after applying, ILMCT will reimburse you the cost of the classes upon completion.

To apply for scholarship alongside registration:

1. In the top margin of the registration form, please print: **"APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP"**.
2. Obtain the Institute & Academy Scholarship application from the ILMCT Website (ilmct.org) or from the Aim website (aimindiana.org).
3. Return the application to Lesley Mosier, Events & Member Services Director, at imosier@amindiana.org (or at the address listed below) no later than Friday, February 19. Scholarships are granted according to need.

Requirements for scholarship assistance

1. You **MUST** be a member of the Indiana League of Municipal Clerks and Treasurers. To become a member, download the 2021 ILMCT Dues Invoice from the ILMCT website (ilmct.org) or Aim website (aimindiana.org) and submit payment to:

2. You must be registered for the Institute. Mail registration to the same address listed above. Remember to mark "APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP" in the upper margin of the form and highlight the appropriate field indicating that you applied for the scholarship.

Mitigating criteria for scholarship assistance

1. Factors that may heighten an applicant's likelihood of securing a scholarship include: the intent to pursue a career as a municipal clerk or clerk-treasurer; a record of community engagement outside the workplace; and membership (or intent to apply for membership) in the International Institute of Municipal Clerks.
2. To extend this opportunity to as many clerks and clerk-treasurers as possible, applications will be weighted according to past Institute attendance, with new applicants receiving top priority, those returning for a second year receiving second priority, etc.
