This professional management position will be responsible for planning and directing the Town's Human Resources functions, facilitating communication and messaging operations both internally and external to the organization, as well as assisting the Town Manager in directing the operations and maintenance of the Town's infrastructure.

About the position:

Responsibilities: Example responsibilities and projects may include:

- Human Resources: Leading initiatives in hiring, performance reviews, employee engagement, compensation, and general support of the people services of the Town of Munster
- Communications: Representing the organization at meetings and events, crafting Town-wide communications such as newsletters and social media messages, and significant interaction with the public
- Infrastructure and Maintenance: Supporting Town operations, including managing contractors, crafting RFPs and evaluating proposals, project-managing special initiatives such as traffic studies, Council initiatives, and other quality of life improvements

Schedule: The Town Manager's office keeps standard office hours of 8:30am-4:30pm. The Deputy Town Manager will also be responsible for representing the Town at regularly scheduled evening meetings, such as that of our Town Council, various commission and committee meetings, and others as needed.

Compensation: The salary range for this position is \$70k-\$90k, commensurate with experience. The Town provides a very competitive benefits package, including comprehensive health care plans, dental, free vision, Indiana PERF, as well as generous accumulated leave policies.

About you:

The successful candidate will demonstrate:

A strong base of relevant knowledge and experience. Such as:

- A bachelor's degree in Public Administration, or other relevant field, and;
- At least three years of progressive municipal government experience
- Applicants with a combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities are also welcome to apply

A genuine, service-oriented demeanor.
