Aim and ICI will host Mayors Institute, December 13 - 14, in Indianapolis. All Hoosier mayors are invited to participate in the Mayors Institute to achieve certification in this exciting city leadership program.

Participation and Recognition in City Leadership

All Indiana mayors are strongly encouraged to attend at least two Mayors Institute sessions each year. Aim and ICI will award mayors a Certificate of Achievement in three levels. Achievement will be measured by participation and attendance at the Mayors Institute sessions. Additionally, mayors that have reached Indiana City Leadership Ambassador status are eligible for an advanced level: Indiana City Leadership Executive.
