June 12-16 ILMCT 85th Annual Conference and State Board of Accounts School

Our annual conference will take place in Michigan City, Indiana. The League will conduct its annual business meeting during the conference as well as the election and installment of officers. ILMCT will offer a day of education. The State Board of Accounts School is a two-day state called meeting. In addition to the State Board of Accounts, representatives from the Department of Local Government Finance, Indiana Department of Revenue, the Internal Revenue Service, the Indiana Public Retirement System and other agencies are invited to provide updates. There will be an exhibit hall for connecting with vendors as well.
