The City of Valparaiso, Indiana seeks qualified candidates for the position of Assistant or Associate Planner. The position reports to the Director of Planning & Transit and fulfills a range of roles within the department. Major responsibilities include development and zoning reviews and permitting; assisting residents and property owners with planning and development matters; providing support for Board of Zoning Appeals, Plan Commission, Creative Council, Historic Preservation Commission, and others; managing regular updates of the Unified Development Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan; support for special planning initiatives like annexations, area plans, grant programs, and studies; coordinating outdoor dining program for downtown businesses; and general planning and zoning research.

Assistant Planner candidates must have a degree in Planning or associated field and at least one year of professional experience. Associate Planner candidates must have either a bachelor's degree in Planning or an associated field and at least four years professional experience or a master's degree and at least two years professional experience.
