

Assistant Maintenance Foreman, WWTP

This position is responsible for assisting the Maintenance Foreman in the maintenance of plant equipment and lift stations for the Wastewater Treatment plant.

What you get to do:

- Function as operator in charge
- Work in confined spaces
- Operate dump truck, loader, tractors, and mowers, required
- Perform preventative maintenance
- Service and maintain all equipment associated with the plant, including trucks, loaders, tractors, mowers, and other equipment
- Service and maintain lift stations
- Minor electrical work such as replacing receptacles, outlets, and fuses
- Recognize equipment abnormalities

Experience and Requirements:

- 1+ year of electrical work
- 1+ year of operating equipment such as trucks, loaders, tractors, and mowers
- 2+ years of general maintenance experience
- Ability to tolerate grease and oil
- Use general hand tools
- Valid driver's license
- Graduation from high school or GED equivalent,
- On-call availability required

Environmental Conditions

- Works outside in all weather conditions
- Exposed to odors, wastewaters, sludges, and chemicals
- Work in confined spaces
