Statement from Indiana's Mayors regarding the Assassination Attempt on Former U.S. President Donald Trump

As Hoosier mayors from the Indiana Conference of Mayors and Indiana Women Mayors constituency group, we come together to address recent events and reaffirm our unwavering commitment to free and fair elections - the cornerstone of our democracy. The attempt on former President Trump's life is deeply troubling. We unequivocally condemn all forms of political violence. Such acts have no place in our society and run counter to the very principles of democracy we hold dear. The strength of our nation lies in our ability to navigate difficult moments with unity, respect, and an unwavering commitment to our shared values. We call on all Hoosiers to join us and stand together in support of our democratic processes, regardless of political affiliation.

Formed in 1998, the Indiana Conference of Mayors (ICOM), is an affiliate of Aim, the advocacy group for Indiana's cities and towns. Its purpose is to give special focus on the needs and concerns of the elected chief executives of Indiana's 120 cities.
